Delivery Requirements

21. <u>Length of Roll (Thaan)</u>: Cloth is to be supplied in 103.5 meter roll. Piece(s) of cloth less than 103.5 meter will be accepted as the multiplication of 3.45 meter but cloth less than 10.35 meter will not be accepted by ACINS.

22. Packaging.

 - (1) Name of Item.

 - (6) Endorsement of ACINS as to inspection and acceptance (ACINS will make endorsement after inspection).
- 23. <u>Delivery Schedule</u>: Cloths are to be delivered at supplier's cost and risk to consignee as per following delivery schedule:

- 24. <u>Warranty</u>: Supplier is to give warranty certificate for Cloth Combat for Fireman which should clearly fulfill following requirements:
 - a. 24 (Twenty four) month self life (from the date of acceptance) against material and colour i.e. colour and material quality will remain unchanged for 24 month in normal storage condition. If the colour becomes faded or material condition deteriorates or any defective item is detected at any time during the warranty period then supplier is to replace defective cloths free of cost to the buyer.
 - b. Warranty should be effective from the date of acceptance.
- 25. Quality Assurance Certificate: Quality assurance certificate from the manufacturer is to be given along with the consignment.
