1.	Name of the item	Coffee.	
2.	Quantity	4,500 Kg.	
3.	Quality	a. The coffee shall consist of pure unroasted seeds of "coffee arabica" of good sound quality. b. When roasted and grind, the beans shall produce a beverage of pleasant taste and characteristic flavour. It should be fit for human consumption.

		Moisture	Max 4.0%
		Ash	Max 15.0%
		Acid insoluble ash	Max 1%
5.	Packing	Caffeine	Min 0.8%
		The packing as required as follows: the coffee shall be packed in wide-mouthed clear glass bottles of good manufacture, firmly closed either with well-fitting corks, sealed with a suitable sealing compound, or with cork lined metal caps. Each bottle be packed in corrugated cardboard cover.	
		Net weight of coffee in a bottle should be within 200-250gm. Each carton (commercial standard cardboard cases), gross weight max upto 10 Kg should be used for transportation and delivery.	
		The ESL period shall be at least 12 months from the date of supply.

8.	Hygiene inspection	Packing and storage area should maintain standard hygienic condition and should be open for inspection at any time, by a competent authority approved by the Bangladesh Navy.	
9.	Organoleptic Test	Samples will be tasted by the Evaluation Committee members and should be found tasty for human consumption.
